



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Trolley Path

In the Neighborhood of Make-Believe, TROLLEY follows the dotted path to each destination. Encourage an interest in transportation, and have FUN creating a unique path for Trolley. DING, DING!

Draw and color or paint small dots on a paper plate.
Or, print and use the template on the next page.
Some children might prefer to make an orderly line of dots with limited colors—and that's grr-ific, too!



Use a pencil to draw the parallel lines of a path, which will be used to create train tracks. For added fun, try creating both curves and straight lines for the course!



Let children practice independently with kid-friendly scissors or assist in cutting the path. For children with sensory considerations, an adult may consider cutting the paper for the child.



Encourage children to glue or tape the pieces independently or work together to create a path with bends, curves, and straights.



Use your favorite small vehicle or toy, the <u>Daniel Tiger Foldable Trolley Template</u>, or the <u>Daniel Tiger Trolley Favor Box</u> craft activity from PBS KIDS on the path.

1. Cut along the dashes to make your stage opening.


2. Fold the side flaps along the solid lines to prop up the stage.

Treasure Hunt:

Go on a hunt in your neighborhood. Select a fun theme for your hunt, (insects, colors, numbers, things that start with the letters of your child's name), and then have fun exploring.

Painted Friendship Rocks:

Paint positive messages and pictures on rocks and hide them in your neighborhood for others to find.

Read together:

Take turns reading to your child and letting your child read to you. Encourage children to read to someone else - a sibling, a neighbor, their pet.

Cooking Together:

Children love to be included in meal time. This is a great way to work on math, science and fine motor skills. Find a favorite recipe and make some memories. Here is a recipe to get you started.

Mom Tiger's Banana Bread

Ingredients

4 overripe bananas

1/4 cup melted butter

1 cup sugar

1 teaspoon baking soda

1 egg

1 teaspoon salt

1 1/2 cups flour

Directions



In a medium bowl, mash bananas with a fork. Stir in other ingredients.


2 Pour into a non-stick or buttered 8 1/2 x 3 1/2 x 2 1/2 -inch loaf pan.

Bake for 1 hour in preheated oven at 325 degrees.
